- we will support complete the forms to get paid.

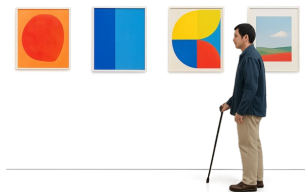
Your art is yours
